ORDINANCE No. 88

**An Ordinance Amending the District Code TO
Establish the Position of District Security Officer**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SIERRA LAKES
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT as follows:**

Ordinance Section One:

Purpose and Intent:

It is the intent of the Board of Directors, in accordance with the authority granted to the District under California Water Code 30547 and Penal Code Section 830.34, to establish one or more positions as District Security Officers, which persons, upon appointment and qualification, shall serve as peace officers whose primary duty shall be the protection of the properties of the District and the protection of the persons thereon.

Ordinance Section Two:

Section 2.10 of the Sierra Lakes County Water District Code, is hereby amended to read, in its entirety:

Section 2.10 Manager - Protection and Repair of District Property –
Appointment of Security Officer(s)

A. The Manager shall promptly report any violation or disrepair of District facilities to the Board. If the work required is in the nature of an emergency, the Manager shall take whatever steps are necessary to maintain service to the customers, pending action by the Board.

B. In accordance with the provisions of Water Code Section 30547, the Board hereby establishes the position of District Security Officer(s). The Security Officer(s) position(s) shall, if authorized and funded by the Board, be reflected in the annual budget as adopted by the Board. In accordance with Penal Code Section 830.34, the Security Officer(s) shall be peace officers whose primary duty shall be the protection of the properties of the District and the protection of the persons thereon.

C. The Manager also shall enforce the provisions of the District Code and the provisions of state law which affect the property of the District and the safety and protection of persons thereon and which affect the District's waters. When one or more Security Officer positions are authorized and funded by the Board, the Manager may hire and appoint an employee to serve as Security Officer, which person(s) shall comply with

the requirements under the Penal Code for Peace Officer Standards and Training. The District shall adhere to the standards for recruitment and training of peace officers established by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training, pursuant to Title 4 of Part 4 of the California Penal Code.

D. In the absence of a Manager, the District Board may hire and appoint District Security Officers.

Ordinance Section Three:

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Placer, State of California.
