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2009 Water System Upgrade Project Updated August 30, 2009

The District has started construction of a significant upgrade to a portion of the water system at the locations shown on the attached map. The low bidder was Lund Construction of North Highlands; staff estimates the total cost of the project including design costs, Placer County permitting and inspection fees, payment to the contractor, construction inspection and construction materials testing to be approximately \$1.046 million. The Contractor's current schedule proposes:

- **August 31st through September 3rd:** Finish mainline related work on Sierra Drive and Dulzura Road
- **September 8th through September 11th:** Install replacement service laterals and complete mainline tie-ins on Soda Springs Road and Hemlock Drive
- **September 14th through September 18th:** Install replacement service laterals and complete mainline tie-ins and finish paving on Lake Drive and Dulzura Road.
- **September 21st through September 28th:** Cleanup, punch-list items and demobilize.

During construction there will be a significant amount of activity, especially in the areas of mainline replacement which may limit your ability to use certain streets at various times. For residents living on the affected streets, there will be temporary interruptions of your water service and times when you may not be able to access your driveway. To minimize these inconveniences the Contractor will be required to:

- Notify you in writing (by means of a door hanger) two working days in advance of any planned water outage. Service interruptions should not occur before 9:00 am and be completed by 4:00 pm on weekdays only. No overnight, weekend or holiday outages are planned.
- Notify you at least four hours prior to blocking your driveway or closing a street to residents of that street. All streets will be opened to at least one way traffic in the evenings, weekends and holidays. The Fire Department will be notified daily if any streets are closed to through traffic.

The work hours will be 7:00 am to 5:30 pm weekdays only until the Labor Day weekend; the Contractor will be allowed to work on Saturdays after September 7, 2009 if requested. Construction equipment will not be allowed to "warm-up" or idle prior to 7:00 am. District Staff will be on-site during construction and available at any time to answer your questions or concerns.

The Board and Staff of the Sierra Lakes County Water District appreciates your patience and understanding this coming summer as we continue the second season of an intensive three year program to upgrade the oldest portions of the water infrastructure.
